

# CORONAVIRUS : SPOTTING PHISHING EMAILS

## Sender Email Address

Always double check the Sender Address, if they seem unusual, it is likely the email is a phishing attempt.

## Personal Information Requests

Legitimate sites do not email you asking for personal information.

## Generic Greetings

A sign of a mass email sent to multiple accounts.

## Links

Always check links in emails, hover the mouse over the link to show where it goes and check the URL.



## Spelling or Grammatical Errors

Official emails are usually vetted for mistakes.

## Urgency / Act Now

Phishing emails try to rush people to take action so users are less likely to spot warning signs of a scam.
